*In some cases, a class code may appear in more than one quadrant. Just pick one. We've accounted for multiple occurrences.*

*There are buildings that represent a class code. For example, the store marked "Dry Cleaners", represents class code 2589-Dry Cleaning and Laundry Store.*

*There are people representing a class code. For example, a photographer taking photos of a bride and groom in quadrant B7 (hint, hint), would represent class code 4361-Photographer-All Employees.*

We'll tabulate how many class codes were correctly identified. At least 25 correct class codes are needed to win, and remember: The more you correctly identify, the bigger the prize.
